REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS (RFP) For ALAMEDA COUNTY WORKFORCE INVESTMENT BOARD CAREER TRANSITIONAL SERVICES

The Alameda County Workforce Investment Board (ACWIB) announces the issuance of a Request for Proposal (RFP) for organizations to provide services funded through the Recovery Act to work with our Rapid Response Team and provide full case management which will include outreach, recruitment, enrollment, testing, assessment, transferable skills analysis, resume writing, job search workshops, job clubs, individual employment plans, career counseling, job placement, referrals to occupational or vocational skills training, and other services as determined necessary for eligible dislocated workers.

This is a three-year procurement, and initially not less than \$200,000 of Recovery Act, Dislocated Worker and Rapid Response funds will be available countywide (except the City of Oakland) for two fiscal years. Contract will begin on October 1, 2009 and may be continued through June 30, 2011 contingent upon availability of funds from the State of California, successful performance, determination of need, and Recovery Act, Dislocated Worker and Rapid Response funding.
